

Bestselling author Anthony DeStefano reveals atheism and its "Gospel of Nothingness," as myth in new book

Inside the Atheist Mind

Unmasking the Religion of Those Who Say There Is No God



Nashville, TN (Nov. 2017) – In a world full of new-age "spirituality," religious skepticism, and ever-increasing secularism, author Anthony DeStefano is exposing the so-called "new" atheism for what it really is: pseudo-intellectual garbage.

The purpose of DeStefano's new book, *Inside the Atheist Mind: Unmasking the Religion of Those Who Say There Is No God* (March 20, 2018; ISBN 9780718080563; \$24.99), isn't to convert atheists into Christians. Instead, DeStefano takes off his gloves and bares his knuckles in a fight against the atheists, themselves. "There is only one way to deal with bullies, even in this politically correct world," says DeStefano—"and that is to crush them."

"Most books written in response to the new atheists have been very respectful and even conciliatory," he continues. "The authors have tried to be kind and reasonable and amiable in an effort to demonstrate that believers don't have to sink into the mud in order to defend their faith. That tact is both charitable and admirable; but unfortunately, it just doesn't work with bullies—and that is exactly what modern-day atheists are: bullies. Instead, I've written this book as unapologetically combative, confrontational, provocative, and aggressive as the books written by atheists like Christopher Hitchens, Sam Harris, and Richard Dawkins."

Employing the same fervor and gusto with which these "new atheists" have attacked Christianity, DeStefano's book is a no-holds-barred retort against their anti-God philosophy, revealing the intellectual bankruptcy at their core and equipping believers to respond to their hollow arguments.



"We live in a functionally atheistic society in which secular values have achieved almost complete dominance in the public square," says DeStefano. "Surveys show that atheism is growing at an alarming rate across the globe. And even people who do not consider themselves atheists think that their professed religious views have little or no relevance in their lives. They are believers in name only. The bottom line is that the world in which we live is literally facing a crisis of faith. We need to fight back *now* before it's too late."

Inside the Atheist Mind provides a fresh, bold perspective on atheists and a devastating takedown of their "philosophy of nothingness." Using irony, wit, and a healthy dose of sarcasm, DeStefano

lampoons, teases, and deflates the atheist position, unmasking it for what it really is—an empty, intellectually barren "religion", devoid of any logic and common sense.
